We will need to have a discussion on this year’s sampling analysis plan because the Division of Water Quality performing intensive monitoring in our area and some new microbial source tracking analyses are available. There will also be a discussion on other monitoring in our watersheds. |
| 2:00-2:15 | MAWP Watershed Management Plan: Review of 2.8.2 Current Water Uses |
| 2:15-2:30 | Discussion of Vulnerability, Consequences and Adaptation Planning Scenarios (VCAPS): VCAPS is a facilitation technique developed to work with municipalities on understanding current and future climate risks. This facilitation technique was developed by an organization similar to Western Water Assessment with the goal to help towns/cities to understand current and future climate risks and to begin to develop a plan to develop adaptation strategies to those risks. This summer/fall they conducted VCAPS projects in Colorado (4) and Utah (1). These projects were focused on the climate risks most important to the specific towns and included drought, water supply and extreme precipitation (thunderstorms/flash floods). So far these projects have either worked with one town, multiple towns or a county. These projects work best if there is one organization that is a “champion” for the workshop, but many of the workshops included some participants from outside the town or county that had relevant expertise. The outcome of these workshops is to produce a report that can serve as a starting point and roadmap for addressing problems associated with climate risks and finding solutions through adaptation. Would the MAWP want to “Champion” this project? |
